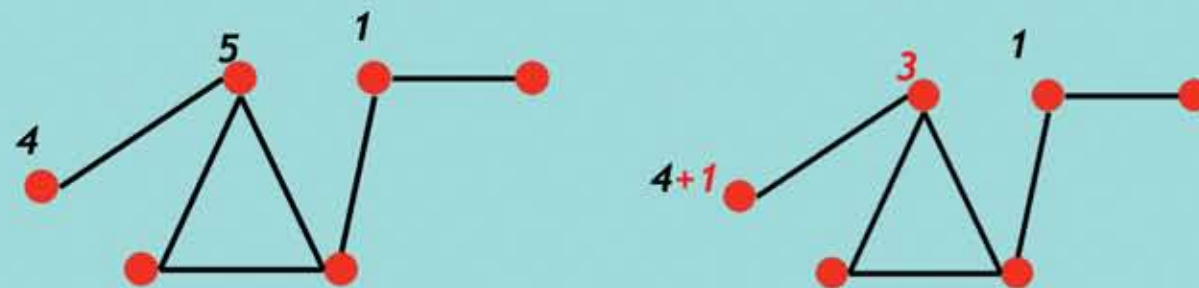


Demonic Graphs & Undergraduate Research
